DDSN is issuing a new Department Directive that outlines the agency's policy for supporting the provision of State Funded Case Management (SFCM) and the procedure to be followed to request this service. This directive replaces DDSN Directive 700-04-DD: Levels of Service Coordination, which will become obsolete on April 30, 2014 at the close of business. The new directive 700-05-DD will be effective May 1, 2014, concurrent with the 45-day review period which will allow for input from the providers while receiving continued updates from the South Carolina Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) regarding Medicaid Targeted Case Management (MTCM).

On May 1, individuals who are currently Level I and receiving services will be approved for staggered periods of time, no less than six months. As these approvals expire, DDSN will review and reapprove service requests in accordance with the new directive.
