Parent/Caregiver Relief Day-Out Programs Saturday Activity Centers

Two Programs: One for Youth Ages 12 to 17 and One for Adults

Designed especially for those individuals who are not receiving the benefits available through the Medicaid Waivers.

The responsibilities of parents and other primary caregivers of individuals with special needs are great and often the resources to provide a “break” are limited or non-existent. The two programs below are offered to provide some relief from the strains of the constant provision of care to a family member with disabilities. They also provide a variety of fun activities such as movies, trips to the zoo, recreational events, etc.

Caregiver Relief Program for Youth – Ages 12 to 17:

The Saturday Activity Center allows you as caregivers a “day off” while your family members with disabilities enjoy leisure time at a TDC center. A variety of activities are planned that include activities in the community. This service is being offered at **no cost** to individuals who are not served through one of the Medicaid Waivers.

Services are provided in a group setting between the hours of 9:30 am and 4:30 pm two Saturdays a month. We alternate between the North Augusta Satellite and the Vaucluse Road Activity Center. Participants may attend either or both sites. Please note that transportation to and from the Saturday Center is NOT provided and is the responsibility of the family/caregiver.

Caregiver Relief Program for Adults:

The Saturday Activity Center allows you as caregivers a “day off” while your family members with disabilities enjoy leisure time at a TDC center. A variety of activities are planned that include activities in the community. This service is being offered at **no cost**

to individuals who are not served through one of the Medicaid Waivers. Participants in the adult program must be age 18 and over.

Services are provided in a group setting between the hours of 9:30 am and 4:30 pm two Saturdays a month. We alternate between the North Augusta Satellite and the Vaucluse Road Activity Center. Participants may attend either or both sites. Please note that transportation to and from the Saturday Center is NOT provided and is the responsibility of the family/caregiver.
