If the parents select a clinician that does not work for the Autism Division, a physician referral is required. In addition, the completion of the STAT is part of the hospital's intake process rather than a separate independent evaluation.

DDSN Autism Division STAT Clinicians

Autism Division clinicians are approved to administer the M-CHAT Follow-Up Interview and STAT for children seeking BabyNet ABA services through the Presumptive Eligibility protocol. The Autism Division clinicians do not charge a fee for administering the M-CHAT Follow-Up Interview or STAT; however, all other approved clinicians will charge a fee. Other clinicians may bill Medicaid if the child is a recipient, insurance if the child is covered, or the family if the child is not a Medicaid recipient or covered under an insurance policy.

The Autism Division has identified one specific person who should be contacted if the Autism Division is selected to complete the M-CHAT Follow-Up Interview and STAT.
