



## DDSN Executive Memo

**RE: Continued DDSN Grant Funding of HASCI Community Opportunity Centers and Previous Rehabilitation Supports Providers Electing to Convert to Waiver Funded Day Program Services**

The purpose of this memo is to notify Executive Directors of HASCI Community Opportunity Centers and previous providers of HASCI Rehabilitation Supports (RS) electing to convert to waiver funded day program services of DDSN's plans for grant funding of these programs in the second quarter of fiscal year 2021.

As noted in the memo dated June 23, 2020, and in previous communications, former RS providers are expected to develop plans for self-sufficiency over time, and to implement those plans as DDSN's funding of these programs fades. DDSN's stated plan was to monitor provider progress toward self-sufficiency in the first quarter of this fiscal year and make a determination regarding ongoing funding based on provider progress. However, the fact that several providers did not reopen until well into the first quarter made it difficult to fairly evaluate progress. As a result, DDSN has determined to continue funding at the same rate of \$28,000 per provider during the second quarter of this fiscal year while providers continue to develop, implement and transition to self-sufficiency models.

### Next Steps:

DDSN recognizes that the timing of the COVID-19 pandemic has impaired the ability of former RS providers to move forward with previous plans for achieving self-sufficiency through expansion. In a COVID-19 present world, all day service providers have been faced with finding creative ways to serve people while accounting for the new normal of social distancing. Former RS providers are expected to re-evaluate their plans for achieving self-sufficiency and apply concerted efforts over the second quarter of this fiscal year. Usage data will be pulled and monthly reports will be provided to all former RS providers to demonstrate effort and progress. Please review July and August reports (attached) compiled by provider to provide intra-and inter-provider comparison data.

DDSN will assess providers' continued needs based on this information and determine the amount of continued support funding that each provider will be awarded for the third quarter of the fiscal year. As previously noted, the current funding is intended to cover a portion of each program's fixed costs, a portion of costs for staff providing the replacement services, and serve as a retainer to allow the programs to maintain operations and assure access by participants.
